

## 2023-24 School Results

All pupils at Belmont School have special learning difficulties and we are very proud of their achievement.

**Phonics Screening** (Year 1 & 2). In 2023/24, two children took the phonics screening check and were marked as Wt (Working Towards the required standard).

**Average Scaled Scores in Reading and Maths** (KS2). No Year 6 pupils in 2023/24 were entered to take National Curriculum tests in Mathematics, English reading, and English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.

**Key Stage 1 Teacher Assessment.** No formal teacher assessment was conducted against the national criteria.

### Key Stage 2

- BLW is awarded if the pupil is below the standard of the tests.
